

Identify the Data Modernization Planning Team

To be effective in addressing the data modernization needs of the organization, public health agencies need to create a team that can support these efforts. It is critical to have a good team to collaborate, contribute and guide the process. Team members must be able to support implementation by identifying training needs, identifying data sets, facilitating agency-wide enterprise services, and championing cross-agency collaboration and sharing among programs. In addition, team members should be future-oriented to look at problems faced now, determine what problems might arise in the future and plan a solution to address them.
